Koinonia Dinner Groups

Koinonia is a Greek word meaning fellowship. It is used to describe not only early Christian groups but also the communal experience in the sharing of our journeys in Christ. Groups of eight members will be formed randomly by drawing names for the purpose of meeting to share a meal and fellowship. Each group is autonomous and decides how, when and where it will meet during the months of September through June. However, in order to form a cohesive "fellowship community", it is suggested that a group get together at least six months during that period. The meals are potluck with the members rotating hosting and providing the main dish. It is not necessary to have a large house or be a gourmet cook. Some of the most enjoyable get-togethers have been eating hot dogs while sitting on the floor!

In talking to member of this year's groups, the most common comments were: "they were fun", the fellowship was great", "gave me a chance to get to know other members of the parish family better", "I go to the early service and don't really get to know anyone from the late service", "food was wonderful", and "I really felt I was a member of the Parish Family".
